李先生特別講演:アジア太平洋時代に臨む

──経済協力問題とアジア経済研究所への期待── (抄)

尊敬する宗像所長,アジア経済研究所の研究者,そして来賓の皆さん! 今日私は,設立30周年を迎える貴アジア経済研究所において,近づきつつあるアジア太平洋時代に臨む韓日両国の位相と役割に対する平素の所見をお話で

きることを大変光栄に思います。

振り返ってみますと、アジア経済研究所の設立当時、すでに米国は海外の軍事費支出等政府支出が増大し、それとともに大企業の多国籍企業化に伴う海外投資のために、国際収支の赤字が慢性化しており、反面ヨーロッパ大陸の6カ国はその1年前にヨーロッパ共同体(EEC)を結成、関係国はそれまでの安定から成長を経済政策の基調に設定するようになりました。日本もまた設備投資中心のいわゆる岩戸景気の絶頂期にありました。

しかしそのころの日本は、国際収支の状況が今日とは異なり、景気の好・不況とともに赤字・黒字が反復する極めて不安定な状態にありました。当時の日本の輸出と輸入はそれぞれ40.6億ドル、44.9億ドルで貿易収支は赤字であり、西欧 (EC と EFTA) の515.1億ドル、571.1億ドルと比較してみると、はるかに小さな規模でした。さらに、国内的には高度成長期に対応して労働市場の構造が大きく変貌しており、政治的状況もまた平坦ではありませんでした。

このように、日本経済がいまでは想像し難いような国内外的に困難な条件にあったにもかかわらず、「アジア地域等発展途上国の経済と関連事情に対する基礎的で、総合的な調査研究を通じてその成果を広く普及し、これら地域との貿易拡大、経済協力の促進に寄与するために」アジア経済研究所が設立されたということは、今日になって考えてみれば、優れた慧眼とまた勇気なくしては不可能だったことと思われます。

それから三十星霜の間、困難な条件のもとにあっても、常に設立の趣旨に透徹し、不断の集中的努力と官民の協調によって、いまやアジア経済研究所は、ひとり日本国内の研究機関であるに止まらず、アジアのそして世界の研究所として貴重な存在となっています。そのことを考えるとき、アジア経済研究所の発展に大きな関心をもっている外国の研究者の一人として、慶賀にたえないものであります。

日本が戦後の廃墟の上にしっかりと立ち上がり、世界の中の経済的地位を確立するようになったのは、国際的視点と実用主義的行動哲学を土台として、企業の現代化と技術の高度化に邁進したためであると、私は信じています。また、それに劣らず経済理論と現実の間の調和のなかで、日本的経済学を模索してきた研究者の皆さんの苦悩に満ちた研鑽こそ、日本経済を今日あらしめた原動力であると考えることができます。

さらに、アジア経済研究所の皆さんの現地語・現地体験・現地専門家の活用による現場主義的地域研究は、日本固有のものに止まらず、いまや普遍的な学問の方法論として体系化され、欧米諸国にまで広く影響を及ぼしているのであります。

このように研究者の皆さんの努力の足跡は、アジアのエコノミストたちに広く評価されています。特に日本との地理的近接性、儒教文化的共通性があり、よく似た経済発展のパターンを歩んでいる韓国は、格別の関心を抱いて皆さんの活動をみつめています。

アジア経済研究所は政府出捐機関ですから、研究の成果が日本経済の発展に 寄与しなければならないという側面を疎かにすることはできないでしょう。し かし、アジア太平洋時代を展望しつつ、研究所の名声や日本経済の世界経済に おける大変重要な位置を鑑みるとき、私は、その研究の世界性志向あるいは研 究の国際的寄与という視点をいっそう広げていかれ、そして世界的研究機関と しての跳躍を遂げられることをあえて期待してやまないものであります。
